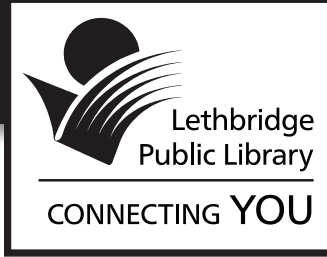

Lethbridge Public Library Update to Services

Lethbridge Public Library has been closely monitoring the developments related to COVID-19. It has been a constantly evolving situation, and we are working in collaboration with our City and provincial officials to ensure Lethbridge Public Library practices reflect new information as it is made available.

As per the provincial government's announcement yesterday, Wednesday, September 15, all visitors to any branch location of the Lethbridge Public Library will still be required to wear a non-medical face mask and practice physical distancing requirements. Medical face mask exemptions will be honoured with a doctor's note.
