PUBLIC MEETING PLACE USE

PURPOSE

The City of Lethbridge Library Board recognizes that areas of its facilities not normally used for library purposes should be available to the public. This policy is in accordance with the Province of Alberta *Libraries Regulation*.

PERSONS AFFECTED

City of Lethbridge Library Board/Library employees/public

POLICY STATEMENT

The City of Lethbridge Library Board provides access to its facilities as a public meeting place for educational, literacy, social, recreational, cultural and business activities.

Areas designated as public meeting places within the Lethbridge Public Library facilities shall be utilized first for Lethbridge Public Library purposes.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The CEO will develop an operational policy which specifies public meeting place terms and conditions.
